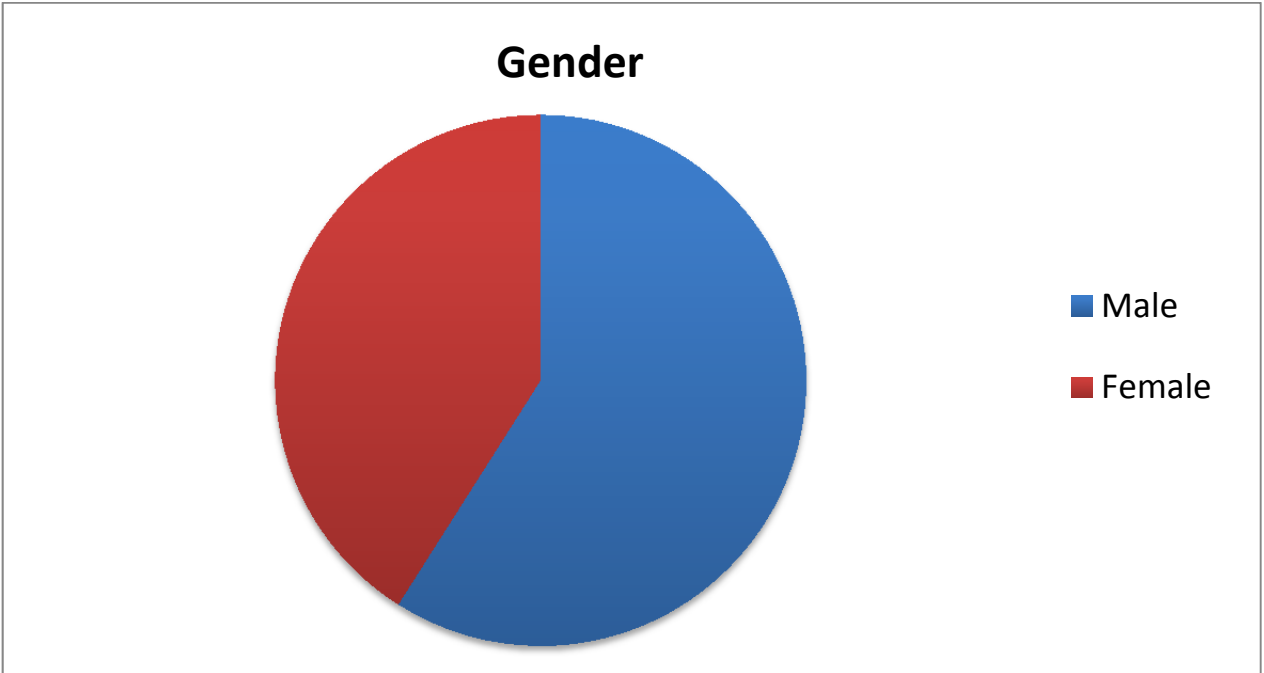
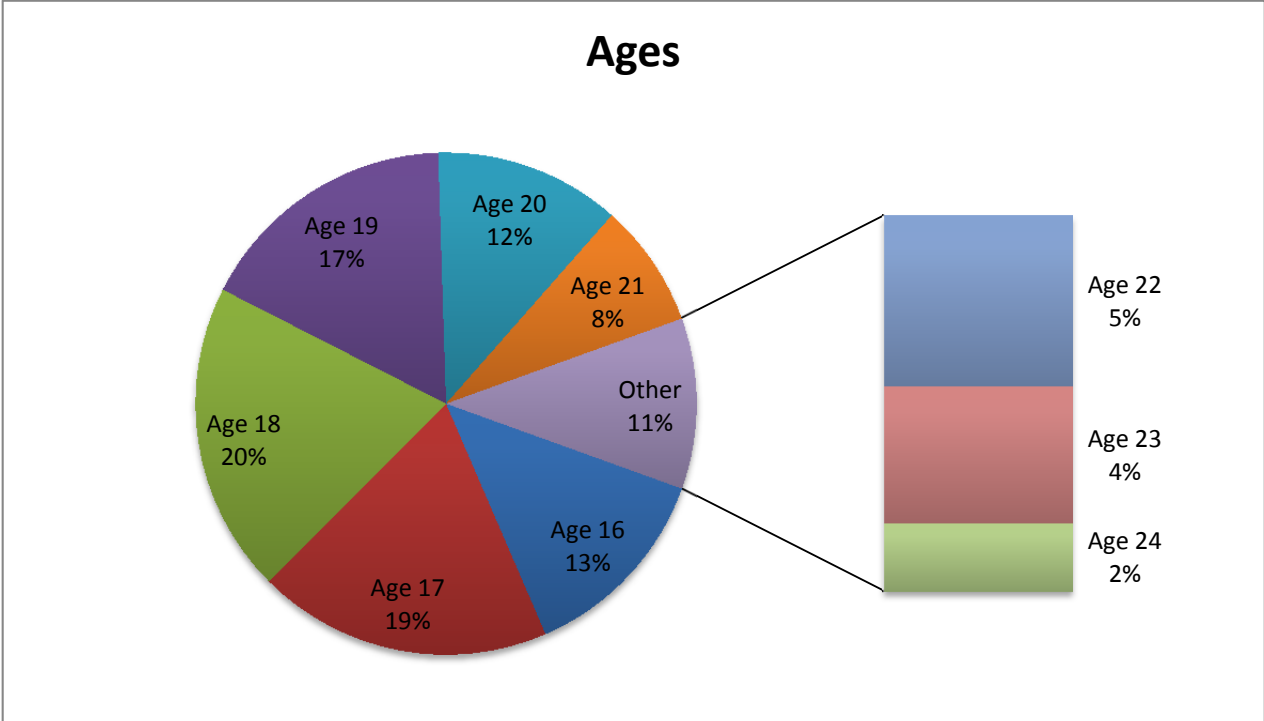
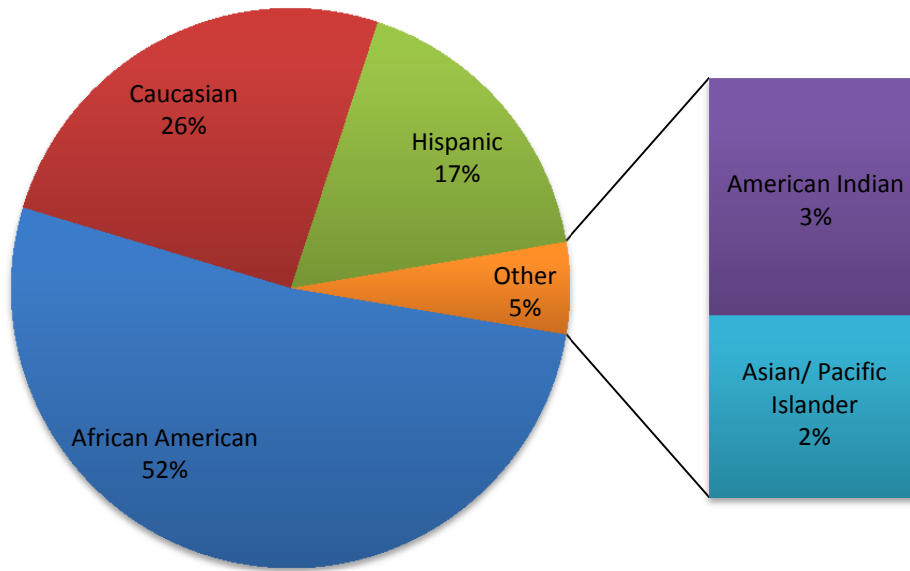


**Student Demographic Profile:**
